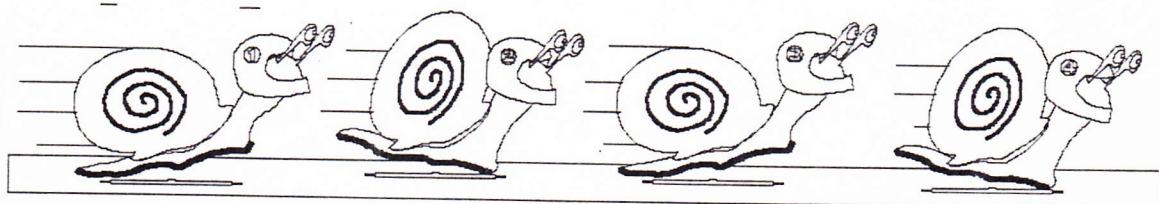


A NOTE FROM THE EDITOR

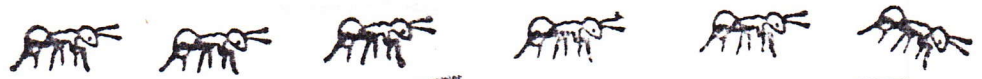

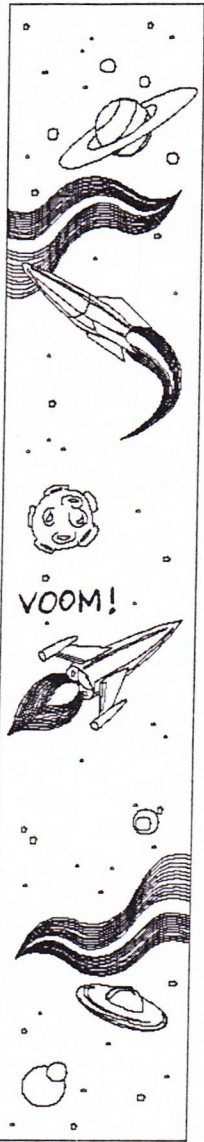

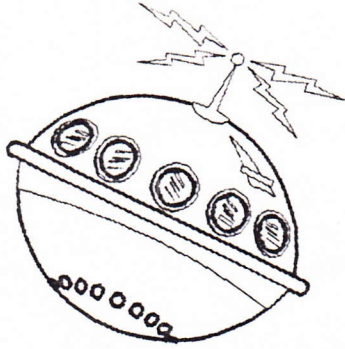

HOW SUPER IS IT?

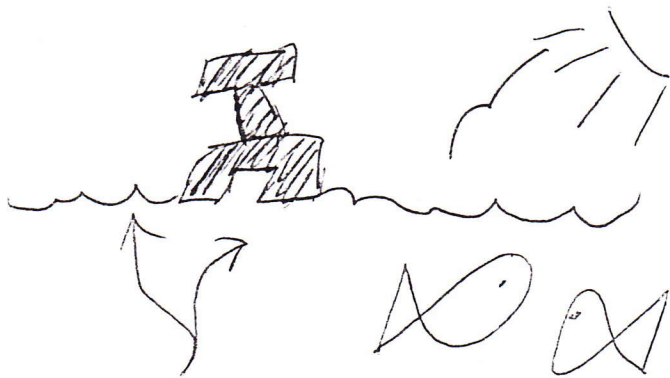

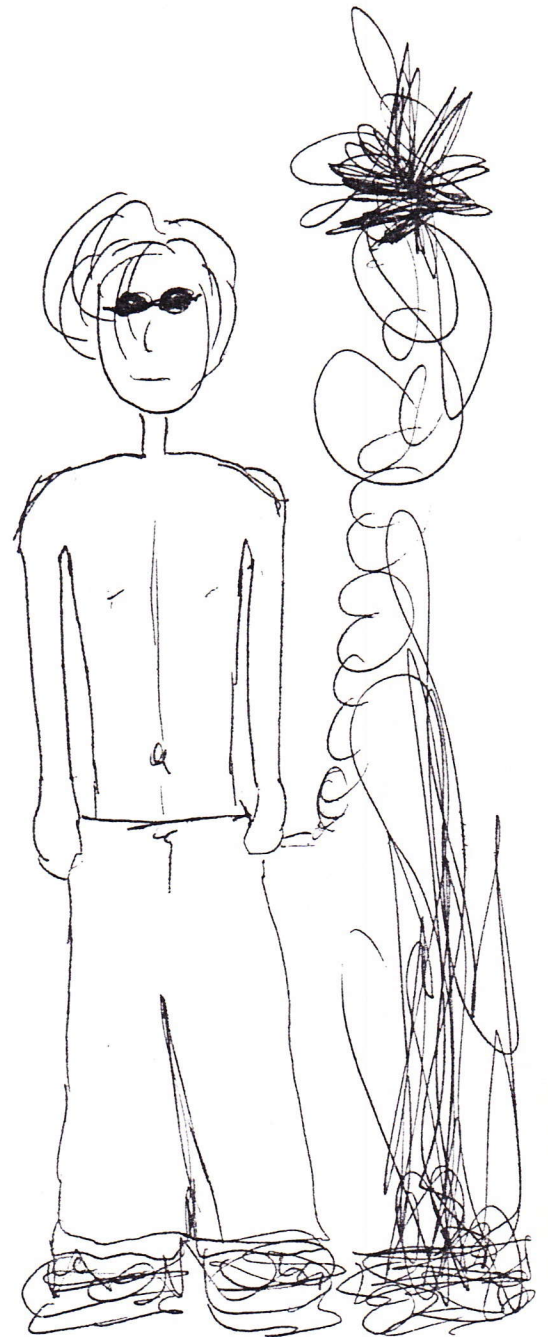

LAST MONTH NineInchNails

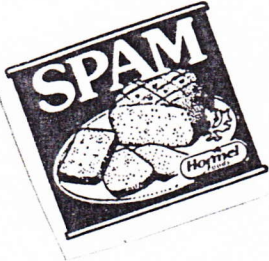

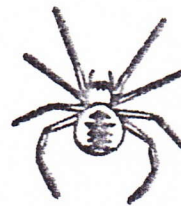
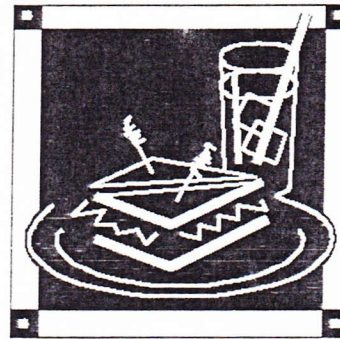


A Meatless Existence?
