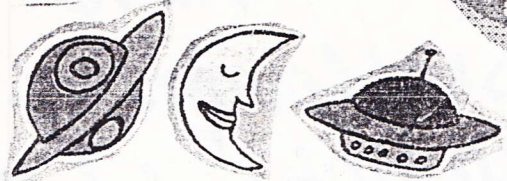
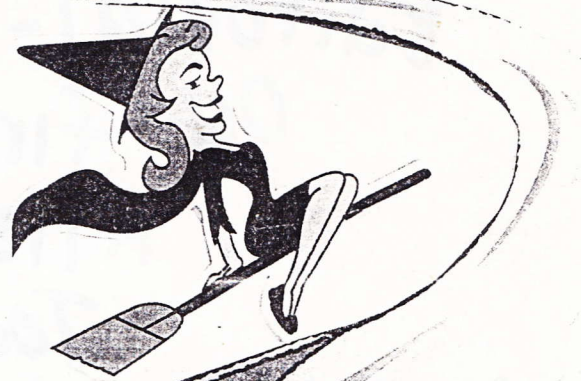

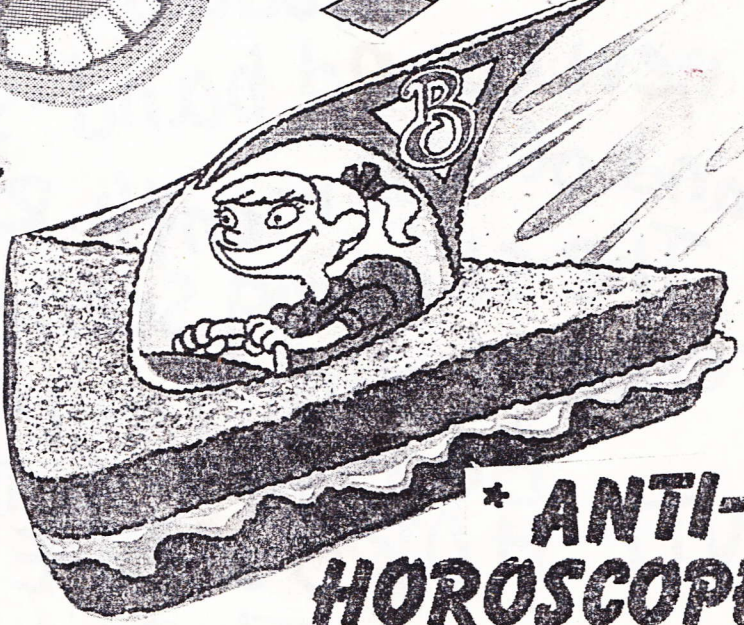

OH MY DEAR!

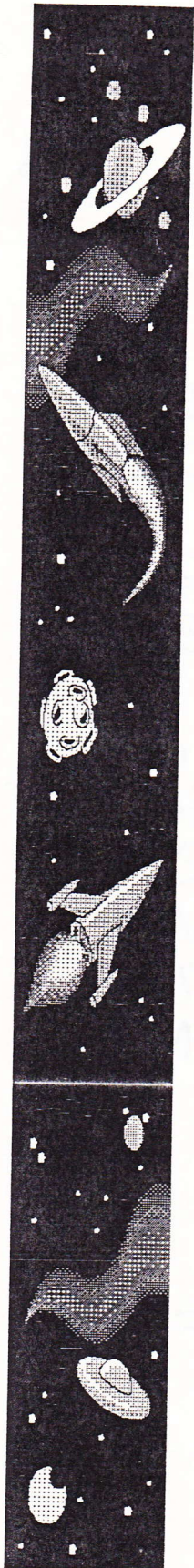

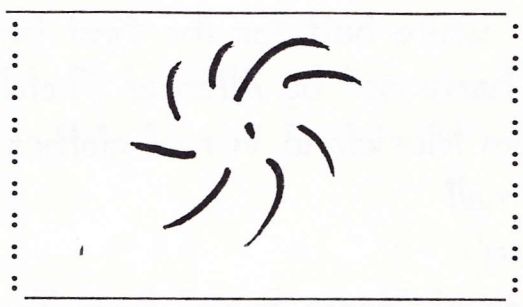

- found a turtle on the side of the road

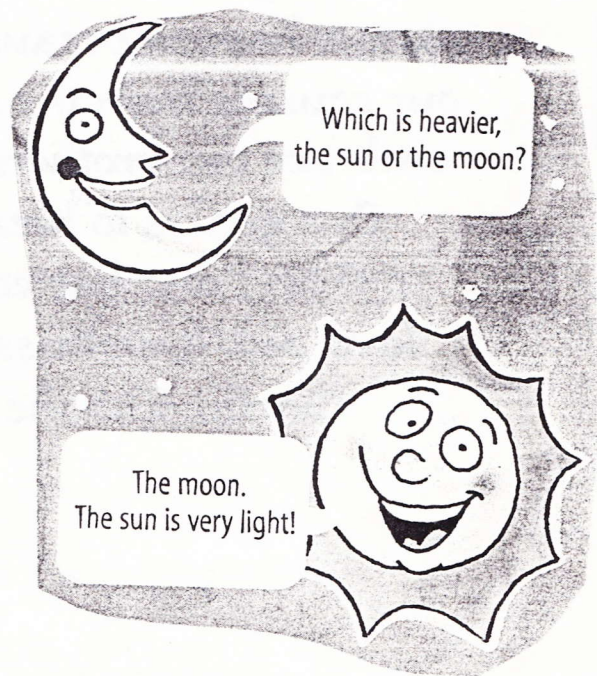

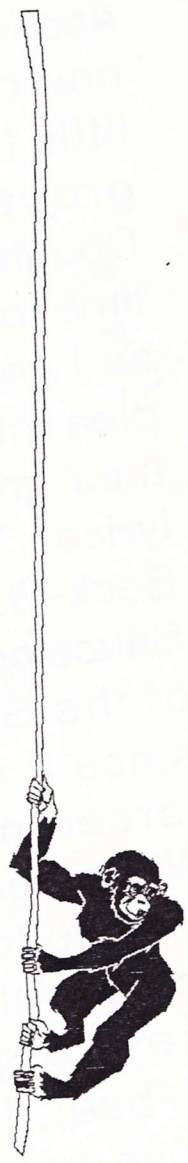

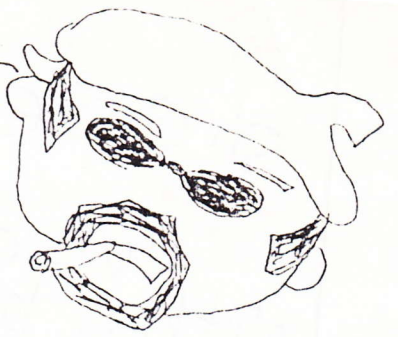
